
STATEMENT OF BELIEFS

The basis of our school is the Bible, the infallible Word of God.
On this basis we affirm the following scriptural principles as guidelines for instruction.

Creation

The universe and all things created by God in the beginning were made good and perfect, as we read in Genesis 1:31, "And God saw everything He made, and behold it was very good."

Man

Through the work of the Holy Spirit we are brought to knowledge of salvation, and receive God's free gift of grace.
