

Bright Beginnings

***Please do not label items except for clothes, folders and backpacks. Thanks!**

- 1 folder (with pockets)
- Backpack or book bag (big enough to carry folders)
- 4 glue sticks
- Set of water colors (Prang brand, all basic colors)
- 1 box of crayons (12-24 count)
- 2 pencils (chunky or thin -- whatever your child is most comfortable with)
- An extra set of clothes (underwear & socks included in a gallon Ziploc bag, just in case!)
- 1 box (or equivalent of) non-perishable snacks to be shared with class
(*animal, graham, round or square crackers, pretzels, fruit snacks—enough to serve 14 children*)
- Box of tissues (large enough to share with class)
- A current photo of your son/daughter -- “head shot” preferably

Pre-Kindergarten

- Book bag or backpack (large enough for folders)
- 2 two-pocket folders (labeled with your child’s name on the front)
- 4 glue sticks (Elmer's, please!)
- 1 non-perishable snack item (enough to serve 15 children)
(*animal, graham, round, square, or fun-shaped crackers-- dinosaur crackers, fish crackers, scooby snacks-- pretzels, fruit snacks, etc.*)
- 1 photo of your child during a summer of 2011 activity!
- 1 set of watercolor paints (Prang or Crayola, please!)

Kindergarten

- Beach towel (to use to designate their resting area—small pillow optional)
- Thick markers—set of 8 to 12 including basic colors
- 2 containers of antibacterial wipes

- Tissues (a small package to fit in desk)

- 1 two-pocket portfolio/folder with 3 prongs in center fold
- 1 plain two-pocket folder for music
- 1 spiral notebook (wide-ruled, 70 sheets)
- 12-inch ruler (inches and centimeters/millimeters—easy to read, no sparkles)
- Thin markers (not permanent) placed in a resealable plastic bag
- 1 fine-line black marker (Sharpie)
- Scissors (good quality)
- Colored pencils (good quality—12 colors) placed in a resealable plastic bag
- A small container to keep lunch/milk ticket supply or spare
- Self stick notes: (Approximately 2 in. x 2 in.)
- Empty, 9 1/2" tall cylindrical food container with cover (i.e. 42oz. oatmeal container, 16.75 oz. Planters Cheez Mania Cheez Curls container or a 10.6oz. Planters Cheez Mania Cheez Balls container.)
- No school boxes, pencil sharpeners, or ring binders, please.

4th Grade

- 1 large box of tissues for classroom (may also bring small box to fit in desk)
- 1 container of disinfecting wipes (e.g. Clorox)
- Small container to keep lunch/milk ticket supply & spares in desk
- 2 two-pocket portfolios/folders w/ holes for binder
- No staplers please
- Clear, shoebox-sized box with lid to hold art supplies (Sterilite 6 qt. Home Essentials is great)

Please put the following items in the above shoebox before you bring it to school:

- 2 ballpoint fine tip pens (1 red, 1 black or blue)
- 2 highlighters
- 2 erasers
- At least 6 sharpened No. 2 pencils—(may bring mechanical pencils in addition; please supply lead)
- 1 package index cards (3 ½" x 5")
- 12 inch ruler (inches & centimeters/millimeters – make sure it's simple/easy to read)
- Crayons – maximum of 48
- Scissors (quality cutting kind, Fiskars or similar brand)
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 fine line black marker (Sharpie)
- Set of colored pencils (at least 12 colors)
- 2 sets of washable markers (1 thin & 1 wide – classics, pastels, or bold)
